

Frankston Little Athletics Centre Championships – Saturday 21st March 2026

General Information/Terms and Conditions of Entry

OPEN TO ALL REGISTERED AND FINANCIAL MEMBERS (Under 6 - Under 17 Athletes) OF FRANKSTON LITTLE ATHLETICS CENTRE

NOTE: First events start at 8:30am and the program will conclude at approximately 1:30pm.

A final timetable will be published on our website in the week prior.

Please read all information below for details about the event/conditions of entry and answers to Frequently Asked Questions.

- Entries:** Entries will be processed using ResultsHQ this season – log in to your family portal by going to <https://resultshq.com.au> and register by clicking on 'Nominations'.

Entries close at 6:00pm on Saturday 14th March 2026. All entries are to be completed online and payment received by this time. **No late entries will be accepted under any circumstances.**
Athletes can enter a maximum of 5 events each.
You can log in and edit which events you have entered up until the closing date/time. Requests to alter events chosen by an athlete cannot be made after this date/time.
If any events are flagged as a 'clash' whilst registering, please disregard and rest assured that you can still select those events – see 'Timetable' below.
Important: The event times and flag locations listed in the registration/nomination portal are based on the 2025 timetable and are to be used as a **guide only**. They are subject to change once entries close and numbers are finalised – see 'Timetable' below.
- Entry Fee & Payment:** **\$3.00 per event or \$12.00 for 5 events** (maximum of 5 events per athlete) plus a processing fee charged by ResultsHQ. As event costing, scheduling and official's rosters are based on entries received, there are strictly **no refunds available once entered**.
Payment can be made online using Visa/MasterCard or PayPal (including debit cards) up until the entry cut off time (6:00pm on 14/03/2026).
- Confirmation of Entry:** Once your entry is complete and payment is received, you should receive a confirmation email. If not, please contact Malcom Huddle (arenamanager@frankstonlittleathletics.com.au) to check the status of your entry.
- Timetable:** The first event commences at 8:30am and the program will conclude at approximately 1:30pm. The final timetable/program for all events will be published on Monday, 16th March 2026.
The timetable will still be subject to change on the day – this will be communicated via announcements of the PA system if required.
A copy of the draft timetable can be accessed [here](#) - however please note that this is intended to be used as a **guide only**, as events may be combined or times changed depending on final entry numbers.
As event costing, scheduling and official's rosters are based on entries received, **entries cannot be changed or refunded after entries close on 14/03/2026, regardless of timetable changes.**

- Marshalling & Clashes:** Athletes are required to marshal at the appropriate flag (as indicated once the timetable is published) **at least 10 minutes prior to their event's scheduled start time**. Announcements will be made as reminders, but individual athletes will not be called over the PA system.
- It is the parent and athlete's responsibility to ensure they marshal on time.
- In the event of a timetabling clash, track events take precedence over field events.** Athletes will need to leave their field event to compete in their track event, and athletes will be able to return to their field event once their track event has concluded.
- Athletes not present by their event's scheduled starting time will be considered as having withdrawn from that event.
- Competition Conditions:** Full and correct FLAC Centre Uniform (including Coles and Commonwealth Bank patches) must be worn, or athletes may be disqualified/ineligible for medals or ribbons and centre records (if applicable) will not be recognised.
- The FLAC Executive/Organising Committee reserves the right to cancel or combine any event with insufficient entries (minimum of 3 entrants per event).
- No protests will be allowed or entered into. The decision of the Competition Director is final.
- Where age groups are combined for timetabling purposes, any official Centre Record achieved will be acknowledged.
- Track Events:** Track events with less than 8 entrants in an age group will be run as a straight final.
- Track events with more than 8 entrants in an age group will be run as a 'timed final' – athletes will be split into heats, and final placings will be determined by fastest times across all heats.
- Field Events:** In field events the best of **four** tries (except high jump) will be judged as the winner.
- In the event of a timetabling clash, *track events take precedence over field events*. Athletes will need to leave their field event to compete in their track event, and athletes will be able to return to their field event once their track event has concluded.
- Medals/Ribbons:** In all events, medals will be awarded to 1st, 2nd and 3rd place.
- Ribbons will be awarded to 4th to 8th place.
- Where age groups are combined for timetabling purposes, results will still be recorded and recognised from each age group **separately** (ie, as if the event hadn't been combined). Medals and ribbons will therefore also be awarded to each age group separately.
- Duties:** Parents must select a duty (one per family) when entering online in order for their child(ren) to be eligible to compete.
- Duties for Centre Championships Day are **additional** to any duties you may have performed throughout the season.*
- Duty is structured differently to a normal competition day – there are slots throughout the day to choose from at different events (maximum 1.5 hours long).
- It is a 'first in, best dressed' system – so get in early to secure the slot you would like. Swaps to another available slot can be done by logging back in to the [ResultsHQ family portal](#).
- If you cannot personally perform the duty you have signed up for, you must arrange for someone else to complete it on your behalf.***
- There are no exceptions to this requirement - athletes whose parents refuse to do duty will be disqualified from competing and be ineligible to be presented with medals or ribbons.***

PARENT/GUARDIAN DECLARATION:

By logging in to the ResultsHQ family portal and completing the entry/payment for your child(ren) to compete in Frankston Little Athletics Centre Championship Day 2026, you indicate that:

- You, the athlete's Parent or Guardian, have read, understood and agree to the information/Terms and Conditions of Entry provided in this document and on the ResultHQ portal.
- You give permission for your child(ren), as a registered athlete of Little Athletics Victoria for season 2025/2026, to compete in the Frankston Little Athletics Centre Championship Day on Saturday, 21st March 2026.
- You understand as a condition of entering, each child may enter a maximum of 5 events.
- You understand that the Centre Championship Day will run from 8:30am until approximately 1:30pm on Saturday, 21st March 2026 and that the timetable is subject to change without notice, and that this will not invoke any right to a refund of entry fees paid.
- You understand that as a condition of entering you child in the Centre Championship Day that it is a requirement that you will sign up to and perform a rostered duty on the day. You further understand that if you do not complete duty as required, your child(ren) will be disqualified from their event(s) and be ineligible to be presented with medals and/or ribbons, and you will not be entitled to any refunds.
- You understand that if entry fee payment is not received online via the ResultsHQ portal by 6:00pm on Saturday, 14th March 2026, that your child's entry will be automatically withdrawn and cannot be reinstated.
- You understand that once entry fee payment is made, it will not be refunded under any circumstances, regardless of whether your child actually competes on the day.
- You agree that your behaviour as a parent will be in line with the LAVic Code of Conduct. You understand that abuse, aggression, intimidation or violence will not be tolerated, and that you may be required to leave the event and your child(ren) disqualified from competing if this Code of Conduct is breached.
